Subject: Lithium Battery - WARNING

Ref: Streamlight Products that Use Lithium Batteries

There have been customer reports of non-authorized lithium batteries exploding or catching fire when used in certain of our products. It is important to note that this is a battery issue and not a flashlight issue.

Streamlight recommends the use of <u>only</u> the following batteries for Streamlight Products that use Lithium batteries of this size:

- Streamlight battery # CR123A,
- Panasonic battery # CR123A
- Duracell battery # 123
- Sanyo #CR123A
- Energizer 123

Furthermore, please heed the following guidelines for your safety:

- Use only the brands of batteries as listed above.
- Prevent the battery from contacting any metal outside the light.
- Replace the batteries in sets.
- Do not mix Old & New batteries in the same light.
- Do not mix different brands of batteries in the same light.
- Do not recharge these batteries.
- Do not disassemble, or expose them to high temperatures.
- Dispose of them properly. Check with your local solid waste officials for details for recycling.
